The City of Milwaukee will hold the second annual Pedestrian Safety Week to raise awareness that motorists must yield to people attempting to cross the street in a crosswalk.

Motorists are required to slow or stop whenever they see a person step off the curb and into a crosswalk. Drivers must yield whether the crosswalk is painted or not. Even if they are not painted, an unmarked crosswalk is the lateral extension of sidewalks on opposite sides of the road at an intersection.

To help raise awareness about this important traffic safety issue, there will be crosswalk demonstrations and police enforcement at crosswalks around the City the entire week.
