- The reconstruction of city streets including East Clybourn Street (East Van Buren Street to North Lincoln Memorial Drive) and the reconfiguration and reconstruction of both North Harbor Drive and North Lincoln Memorial Drive from East Michigan Street to East Chicago Street.*
