EXECUTIVE ORDER #237

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Milwaukee Department of Neighborhood Services Employee Greg "Ziggy" Zyszkiewicz

WHEREAS, on Wednesday March 22, 2017, Greg Zyszkiewicz, a Special Enforcement Agent for the Milwaukee Department of Neighborhood Services, was tragically shot and killed while on duty; and

WHEREAS, Greg Zyszkiewicz was a dedicated City of Milwaukee Department of Neighborhood Services employee for 33 years; and

WHEREAS, Greg Zyszkiewicz was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, public servant and a valued member of his community in the Milwaukee area; and


WHEREAS, Greg Zyszkiewicz was a proud veteran of the United States Army where he served in an artillery unit; and

WHEREAS, the death of Greg Zyszkiewicz has impacted his family, community, and the people of the State of Wisconsin, who now remember his legacy and mourn his passing;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, **beginning immediately and ending at sunset on the day of Greg Zyszkiewicz's interment.**
