Well ...not Johann Sebastian Bach in person – he died in 1750 – but for a Milwaukee area choir that performs in the classical tradition.

Under the direction of **Conductor Jonathan Kim**, our choir performs music from the medieval and Renaissance eras to Bach to modern classics and beyond. We sing a great deal of sacred music, but we also sing secular music including popular music arranged for choral performance.

There are opportunities for soloists in our repertoire.

Our first concert in the 2022-2023 season is entitled “American Dreams”. We will include American composers from Billings to Barber, featuring early Americana like “Shenandoah” as well as modern compositions by Aaron Copland, Samuel Barber, Moses Hogan and Randall Thompson.

Our Epiphany Concert will be built around Vivaldi’s Gloria and our spring concert on Palm Sunday will be centered around sacred music.

Our rehearsals – from 7:00 pm- 9:00 pm on Tuesday nights - are serious but also entertaining and sociable.
