



Photo Internship

ThirdCoast Digest, Milwaukee's home for focused, detailed and comprehensive arts & culture coverage, is currently looking for one individual to serve as a photo intern for Spring 2013. TCD's photo intern will be expected to work a minimum of 10 hours a week, either in-office or out in the field, and will work directly with senior editor Tom Strini, assistant culture editor Matthew Reddin and photo editors Lacy Landre and Angela Morgan. Applicants do not have to be current students or recent graduates, but for current students applying, college credit can be offered should they desire it.

Duties may include, but are not limited to:

- Take and edit photos for stories, under the direction of TCD's photo editors
- Crop photos to fit into front page feature spots for TCD's editorial team
- Take on various assignments around the city to capture events as they happen
- Help collect promotional photos from various media groups
- Generating story ideas

Ideal interns will fit the following qualifications:

- Access to a digital DSLR camera and basic photo editing software
- Knowledge of copyright laws and open source material re: stock imagery
- Fresh ideas and a willingness to explore Milwaukee and surrounding areas
- Familiarity with Wordpress and/or online publishing
- Basic understanding of Pinterest, Flickr and Tumblr as methods of promoting images through social media
- Ability to prioritize assignments and meet short deadlines

Additionally, intern applicants with experience recording and/or editing film/video projects should indicate that when applying. However, video experience is not required to apply, nor will it be expected on the job if a photo intern without that experience is selected.
