SUBJECT: Total Funding for and Enrollment in K-12 Education and Private School Choice

Programs

At your request, I am providing information regarding total funding for the private school choice programs and K-12 education, as well as enrollment in the private school choice programs and public K-12 schools.

Under the private school choice programs, the state pays a statutorily-determined amount for each pupil attending a private school under the programs. The attachment shows the GPR appropriation amounts, aid reductions, and net GPR cost of the Milwaukee, Racine, and statewide private school choice programs from 2009-10 to 2016-17.

Since the beginning of the Milwaukee private school choice program, the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) has been required by law to reduce the general aid for which the Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) is eligible in each year by a percentage of the estimated total cost of the program. In 2015-16, the percentage was 28.8%, and this percentage will be reduced by 3.2 percentage points each year until no aid reduction is made beginning in 2024-25.

Additionally, beginning in 2015-16, the full cost of payments for incoming pupils in the Racine and statewide private school choice programs (pupils who begin participating in those programs in the 2015-16 school year or later) is reduced from the general aids that would otherwise be paid to those pupils' school districts of residence. School districts are able to count those pupils for general aid purposes on a prior year basis, and receive a revenue limit adjustment for the current year. In 2015-16, the revenue limit adjustment for each pupil was equal to each district's base revenue per pupil. Beginning in 2016-17, the revenue limit adjustment will be equal to the amount of the aid reduction.

The attachment also shows the amounts appropriated for K-12 state aid payments in each year from 2009-10 to 2016-17, as well as the statewide gross school levy and the sum of state aid

payments and the school levy. Additionally, the attachment shows the number of pupils enrolled in each choice program and the number of pupils enrolled in K-12 public schools statewide.
