THE BELOW NAMED COMPLAINANT BEING DULY SWORN, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF STATES THAT:

Count 1: FIRST DEGREE RECKLESSLY ENDANGERING SAFETY, USE OF A DANGEROUS WEAPON

The above-named defendant on or about Friday, April 20, 2018, at 2008 West Center Street, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did recklessly endanger the safety of CDK, under circumstances which show utter disregard for human life, contrary to sec. 941.30(1), 939.50(3)(f), 939.63(1)(b) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class F Felony, the defendant may be fined not more than Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), or imprisoned not more than twelve (12) years and six (6) months, or both.

And further, invoking the provisions of sec. 939.63(1)(b) Wis. Stats., because the defendant committed this offense while using a dangerous weapon, the maximum term of imprisonment for the felony may be increased by not more than 5 years.

Count 2: POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY A FELON

The above-named defendant on or about Friday, April 20, 2018, at 2008 West Center Street, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did possess a firearm, having been convicted of a felony in this state, contrary to sec. 941.29(1m)(a), 939.50(3)(g) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class G Felony, the defendant may be fined not more than Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), or imprisoned not more than ten (10) years, or both.

Probable Cause:

I am a City of Milwaukee law enforcement officer and I base this complaint upon my review of official Milwaukee Police Department incident reports, which are of the kind I have used in the past and found to be truthful and reliable and which I know are prepared in the ordinary and regular course of business. Said reports indicate the following:

On April 20th, 2018, at approximately 10:30pm, the defendant, Demetrius Blakes, was at 2008 W Center, City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, WI. At that location is a gas station. While at that location, the defendant encountered the victim, CK. The two briefly spoke, then engaged in a physical fight involving fists. During that fight, the defendant pulled out a handgun and fired at CK, striking him in the abdomen. The victim then went to the trunk of his car and retrieved a shotgun at which point the defendant fled the scene. The defendant was identified in a photo array by CK as well as CR, who was there with the victim CK. The incident was also captured on surveillance video from the gas station.

Complainant has also reviewed CCAP records, relating to Milwaukee County Case 2006CF001639 which reveal that the above-named Defendant Demetrius Blakes was convicted of Burglary-Building or Dwelling, a Class F felony, on May 26th, 2006. That conviction is of record. Those documents reveal that Blakes was sentenced to 30 months probation on July 10th, 2006. C copy of a certified record of conviction is attached.
