We kept playing cat and mouse for several hours, blocking them every time they tried to turn into Wauwatosa. We took a real light barrage of rocks, bottles and eggs. That was returned with (b) (7)(E) was deployed 3 times. The main group gave up, went back into central Milwaukee and have been causing a little ruckus there. We have small groups of cars driving recklessly that are being stop stocked but that's about it.

We are securing earlier than planned. We will be back out tomorrow. Not sure yet if there be more planned events now that the decision has been announced.

I just got off a conference call. Protests are scheduled for 15:00 in Milwaukee in the downtown area already. Social media is gaining traction but not yet a difference maker. Another flash point is the Minnesota Officer was released from jail today, (b) (7)(E).

Subject: Wauwatosa Night 2

Night 2 in Wauwatosa was more involved. Again the protest groups gathered in Milwaukee and then began their travel towards Wauwatosa. The group learned from the previous night and split into smaller groups and would not directly engage the armor as they did the night before. We conducted a lot of intel surveillance on multiple groups of 30 or so cars. We began to make arrests once curfew began and the groups began to split up even more. (b) (5)

(b) (5). Stop sticks were deployed multiple times and culminated in our being able to stop a group of 15 or so cars with elements in front of and behind. The order was given for mass arrests and announcements were made and we began to remove people from vehicles and place them under arrest. Among those arrested were (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

(b) (5) In total around 30 arrests were made. The arrestees were split between Wauwatosa, West Allis and Waukesha. Large groups then gathered at the West Allis PD to which we responded to assist but the group dispersed on their own. The group then went to the Waukesha County Jail to which we responded to assist at as well. We monitored the groups as they traveled back into Milwaukee County on the freeway at speeds in excess of 100 + mph, but did not engage them on the freeway as a pursuit would be inevitable. The groups bypassed Wauwatosa and went into Milwaukee where the split up. We are standing by to ensure they don't regroup and will cut around 04:00 if nothing else starts up.

Subject: Wauwatosa Day 3

Tonight started earlier than the previous nights. Upon starting our PM shift we were notified of a large group again massing in Milwaukee and moving west to Wauwatosa. This group made for City Hall and merged with another group already there. Potentially 100-150ish walkers and 50 or so vehicles. Resources were put in place to contain try em as was done the first 2 nights. Immediately at curfew, 7pm, announcements were given to disperse. Announcements were given until 8pm when armor and crowd control began to push the group east kn North Ave. When bottles and rocks were thrown (b) (7)(E) was sent out. As the group was pushed east reports began to come in of damage to businesses and fires being lit. We responded to the potential fires and found groups pulling dumpsters into intersections, presumably to light on fire. As We approached they pushed the dumpsters about a half block at our vehicles and fled. We merged with the armor pushing east and continued the push in our vehicles and on foot. Multiple arrests were made including one protester who was carrying a backpack of lighter fluid. All in all I would say 20 or so were arrested. (b) (5)

We responded there but did not need to do anything. The group left on their own. Things have been quiet since.
