By my count we have had (3) of these "Chalk the Walk Events" in Milwaukee and they have all been peaceful. The crowds consisted mostly of families and their kids, and usually incorporate some speeches. They're good about posting their marching route (if applicable), gathering point and timeframe. Additionally, for our events the groups abided by the timeframe they posted. Crowds sized varied with largest being approximately 300 at the event by the Art Museum. Hope this helps.

Protests / Demonstrations Today

From 08/13/20 to 08/19/20, the group Created Equal (RID) will host a multiday event called Pro Life Protest at the DNC at the Wisconsin Center and other locations in Milwaukee. They will have banners and posters at different highway overpasses leading in Milwaukee during the DNC. They will also have a mobile jumbotron screen showing videos (location TBD). No indication of civil disobedience. Facebook indicates 5 are going, 23 are interested.

Protests / Demonstrations During DNC

1. On 08/16/20, from 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM, the group **Bernieovest (NRID)** will host an event called **BernieOrVest Ramp Up Party** at Washington Park. The purpose of the event is for ramp up party to conduct safety training, first aid demonstrations, and pass out yellow vests. No indication of civil disobedience. Facebook indicates **27** are going, **162** are interested.
2. On 08/16/20, from 3:00 PM to 4:30 PM, the groups **Wisconsin for Bernie (NRID)**, **Our Wisconsin Revolution (NRID)** and **Our Wisconsin Revolution Milwaukee (NRID)** will host an event called **Wisconsin Delegates Uniting for Peace** at the Peace Billboard at West Wells and James Lovell Streets (one block from the Wisconsin Center).
