Dear Ms. Wiza:

Thank you for your recent National Register Questionnaire submittal regarding the **Mitchell Park Horticulture Conservatory Domes** located at 524 S Layton Boulevard, in **Milwaukee, Milwaukee County**. Based on the information provided we believe the property may be eligible for listing in the State and National Register of Historic Places. It would be eligible under Criterion C, significant for method of construction.

Regarding whether this property is eligible at the national level of significance, the Resource Evaluation Committee did not believe there was enough information to form an opinion. The option of national significance has not been ruled out; however, research will need to be conducted to demonstrate and substantiate that the significance of the property compares favorably at the national level.

This is only a preliminary assessment based on the information supplied to us. If you decide to proceed with a nomination, substantially more research and documentation will be required. Because the preparation and documentation required for a National Register nomination is a complex undertaking, we recommend that a consultant be hired. We have enclosed a list of people who have expressed interest in preparing nominations and who have recently successfully completed nominations in Wisconsin.
