YEAR END REVIEW

January 1—December 31, 2022-2024

Part I Crime

2024 compared to 2023:

- Part I crimes have decreased 4% (25,487) from (26,508)
- Homicides decreased 23% (132) from (172)
- Property crime decreased 4% (16,352) from (16,975)
- Carjackings increased 11% (513) from (463)

Crash Data

2024 compared to 2023:

- Crashes decreased 1% (14,348) from (14,494)
- Hit and run crashes were consistent (5,399) from (5,409)
- Fatalities decreased 11% (66) from (74)

Clearance Rates

In 2024, the homicide clearance rate was 78%.

Data Methods: Part I crime data was obtained from the DCS Fact table and counts distinct incidents (with the exception of rape, aggravated assault and human trafficking which count victims) for the time period of January 1—December 31, 2022-2024. Homicide and non-fatal shooting data was obtained from the OMAP Homicide and Non-Fatal Shooting databases and counts victims for the same time period above. Carjacking data was obtained from the OMAP Carjacking database and counts distinct incidents for the same time period above. Crash data was obtained from TraCS 10 and counts distinct crashes for the same time period above. Fatal crash data was obtained from OMAP Fatal Crash database and counts victims for the same time period above. UCR Homicide clearances were obtained from the Homicide Division and reflects homicides cleared by arrest or exceptional means and include prior year clearances.
