## Senator Jodi Habush Sinykin Praises Governor Evers' Proactive Plan to Address PFAS in Our Water

MADISON, WI – Today, Governor Tony Evers announced new comprehensive plans for his upcoming 2025-27 Executive Budget to address toxic PFAS contamination in Wisconsin's water, a long-standing challenge facing too many of our communities. This action builds upon previous proposals by both the Governor and Wisconsin Legislative Democrats to ensure all Wisconsinites have access to safe, clean drinking water. Senator Jodi Habush Sinykin (D-Whitefish Bay) released the following statement:

"I am pleased to see the Governor step up and show common-sense leadership, once again, to address these dangerous chemicals in Wisconsin's water sources. PFAS chemicals have been linked to serious adverse health effects in humans and animals.
