The *Inspired to Lead* gala is a key fundraiser supporting PEARLS' mission. This year, the event aims to raise \$375,000 to continue providing life-changing programming for Milwaukee's young women and gender-expansive youth. The gala will be emceed by Chauntel McKenzie, CEO of The PowHER Network. Entertainment will include musical performances by Brew City Soul, a Milwaukee-based soul music band specializing in music direction and curation. Featured dancers are from YWCA of Southeastern Wisconsin choreographed by award-winning choreographer and director, Frank Gatson, Jr. The event will be chaired by Board Members, Caitlin Cullen and Tiffany Henry.

Attendees will enjoy an evening of inspiration, catered dining experience and present an Alumnae with the PEARLS Chrysalis Award. The event will also include silent auction, live auction, wine pull, and a special appeal to directly support PEARLS' work.
