- Sort by Filters: Search for destinations and filter by flight duration, personal interests, and specific airlines.
- Explore Destinations: View videos to learn about museums, parks, attractions, and more in each city while also reading expert reviews and local tips.
- Itinerary Builder: Save destination attractions to a custom playlist and easily share it with family and friends.
- Easy Booking: Go directly to the airline's website when ready to book by clicking on "Book Flight."
