More than 25 local and regional artists will display their one-of-a-kind creations inside the greenhouse, offering a diverse selection of artwork for sale, including jewelry, ceramics, woodwork, paintings, and more.

This vibrant event celebrates artistic expression while fostering community connections. Alongside the art exhibits, guests can enjoy live music and a variety of food and beverages from local vendors, creating a lively and welcoming atmosphere for all who attend.

Admission includes access to the art festival, The Domes, and parking. Friends of the Domes members receive free entry, while general admission is \$10 (\$5 for children ages 3-12; free for kids 2 and under). All proceeds support Friends of the Domes in its mission to preserve and sustain the Mitchell Park Domes for future generations.
