Wisconsin Democrats release bills to fight back against ongoing unlawful actions by President Trump and Republicans

MADISON, Wis. — Today, Legislative Democrats introduced legislation to safeguard public programs, protect the civil rights of Wisconsinites, and secure the privacy of our most vulnerable neighbors. Wisconsinites deserve to have a government that protects the people. This package of bills commits to protecting the people of Wisconsin by giving Wisconsinites tools to push back on the unlawful Republican attempts to strip essential public programs, violate civil rights, and compromise the privacy of countless individuals.

The authors of the Protect Wisconsinites Package issued the following statements following the announcement:

Rep. Renuka Mayadev (D-Madison): "The Trump Administration's unlawful and unconstitutional actions knows no bounds. We will not sit back and watch Donald Trump pick the pockets of hard working Wisconsin taxpayers. We need to speak the only language that Trump and his Billionaire Buddies understand – money. The two bills I've authored are proactive financial measures to protect Wisconsinites."
